School Improvement

In our Academy Improvement Plan we are focussing on fostering confidence and empowering our pupils to make positive decisions and develop emotional intelligence. Across the Multi Academy Trust (MAT) we have invested time and training to introduce Trauma Informed School (TIS) strategies across the schools to make an impact upon pupils self-belief and progress. The five core principles of TIS are: safety, trustworthiness, choice, collaboration and empowerment . These principles are being identified by staff when planning teaching and learning provision. St Stephens was delighted to host the TIS training day led by Ellie Baker and welcomed staff from five of the MAT schools on the first day of this term.
