English: Can I retell a story using a story map and actions? Can I use the structure of the story to write my own, similar story? Can I use a capital letter? Can I use finger spaces? Can I use a full stop? Can I use adjectives to make my writing exciting? Can I use repetition for rhythm and description? Can I use simple noun phrases? Can I use standard verb forms - qo/went? Can I talk about the features of a dictionary/list? Can I write my own dictionary/list using images and key facts?

Music: Can we create a piece of weather music?

Can we participate in singing assembly each week?

Art: Can we use materials creatively? Can we use colour and pattern creatively? Can we use painting to develop and express our ideas and experiences? Can we compare differences and similarities between artwork? Can we evaluate and analyse our artwork?

P.E: Can we master movements such as running, jumping, throwing and catching? Can we play team games? Can we develop tactics for attack and defence? Can we play competitive games?
