Year 6 curriculum links

Topic : The World at War.

History : Explore the concept of invasion.

D&T: Understand seasonality and know how to grow, prepare and source a range of wild and grown food.

Music : Rehearse and perform using a variety of outdoor-made instruments.

Develop listening skills by describing the pitch, tempo and dynamics of sound.

Writing : Use of complex expanded noun phrases.

Year 5 curriculum links

Topic : Invaders

Science: Describe the movement of the Earth and other planets.

Explore the occurrence of night and day.

History : Explore the concept of invasion, through the Normans.

Art: Explore sculpture using a range of materials.

Writing : Addition of phrases to add detail, precision and description to sentences.

Year 4 curriculum links

Topic : It's All Greek.

Science : Explore solids, liquids and gases.

Explore changes of state.

Explore the water cycle.

D&T: Select from and use a range of materials and components, including textiles / ingredients.

Writing : Innovate / invent writing sequence – specific nouns and adjectives, powerful verbs and adverbial openers.

Survival skills: Fire

Fire safety and appropriate dress; fire safety; tool safety; constructing a fire; importance of fire to Humans in history; den building.

Camp fire cooking

Melting marshmallows; camp fire bread sticks, dandelion pancakes, storm kettle hot chocolate.

Seasonal art activities

Natural dyes; bug hotels; tree ID; clay leaf printing; bird feeders; grass jewelry; willow shapes; bug hunting.

Naturalist woodland craft: Trees

Knot tying; woodland tree decorations; journey sticks; toasting fork; plaiting; clay tree faces; lashing & joining; magic stick.

Alternative outdoor sports

Welly wanging; rolling tyres down a hill; rolling down a hill; shelter building.
