Next Steps:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Review what makes learning fun and engaging for the class and build teaching around their interests. • Adults/Parents in Year 3 to ensure the behaviour policy is followed by all pupils and school rules are clearly understood by all. • Class "Pupil Forum" members to share playtime ideas within their meetings.
