Results – Progress (End Year 2 to end Year 6)		
2 Levels progress = National minimum age related expectation		
2+ Levels Progress - Reading (Expected Progress)	93%	91%
More than Expected Progress - Reading	32%	33%
2+ Levels Progress - Writing (Expected Progress)	100%	94%
More than Expected Progress - Writing	25%	36%
2+ Levels Progress – Maths (Expected Progress)	96%	90%
More than Expected Progress - Maths	39%	34%

Commentary on Results:

- Cohort was made up of 28 pupils.
- Percentages for attainment and progress are in line with/above national averages at L4+
- Outcomes show the vast majority of pupils achieve well against national average benchmarks
- Combined L4b+ (DfE definition of a "good" L4) was 82% which was above the national average 2015
- L6 was achieved by 7% of cohort in Maths and 4% of cohort in Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling in line with national average 2015
- There are no ARB Class pupils included in the KS2 2015 data set

Next Steps for the Academy:

- Implement the learning improvement priorities detailed in the Academy Improvement Plan 2015/16. Summary below:
- 1. Improve children's independence skills through focus on learning powers and development of learning habitats.
- 2. Improve Phonics at KS1
- 3. Improve KS1 Writing
- 4. Improve progress of writing in KS2 so a higher percentage of children make more than expected progress
- 5. Improve attainment of higher level writers at KS2- focusing on developing boys/ PPG writing
