We are not suggesting doing all these jobs. We would suggest 2 verbal sessions a week, 1 Maths and we leave the other choice of activities for you to decide.

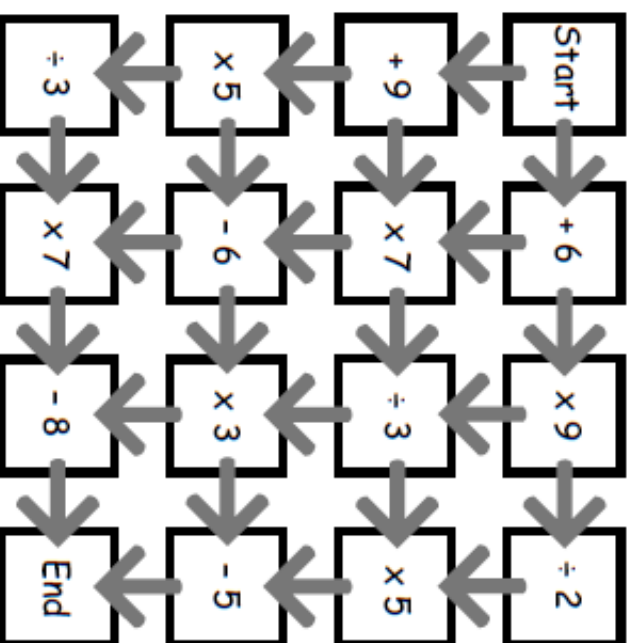

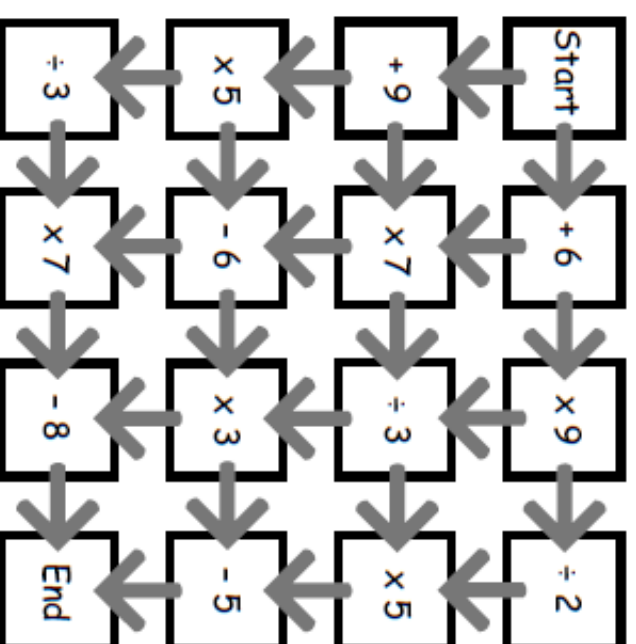
