







	<p>up to the yak, then down a horn, up a horn, under his head and curl</p>
	<p>w: up to the worm, then down, up, down, up and across</p>
	<p>z: up to the zip, then zig-zag-zig down the zip</p>
	<p>q: up to the Queen's head, round her head, down her hair and flick</p>
