Next Steps:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Year 3 Adults to continue to develop independent learning skills and habitats linked to building learning power Year 3 Adults to ensure that behaviour policy is being implemented for effect. Year 3 Adults to conduct more detailed pupil voice survey on behaviour. Year 3 Adults to review impact of homework being set and seek more detailed views from children. Year 3 Pupil Forum representatives to meet with whole school pupil forum to discuss identified issues e.g. golden time activities
