Next Steps:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Adults in Year 6 to continue to ensure that that the behaviour policy is used effectively and develop a positive classroom atmosphere from a pupil perspective • Year 6 adults to explore with children ways to make lessons interesting and fun • Class members on "Pupil Forum" to share outcomes with forum and come up with ideas to address highlighted issues i.e. consider ways to develop equipment and outdoors/ consider attendance certificates for 95% plus
