### **Commentary on Results:**

- Attainment in line with or above national average attainment outcomes improving over 2011 school attainment outcomes.
- Progress above national average progress outcomes improving over 2011 school progress outcomes.
- L5+ attainment particularly strong and showing an improving trend
- Progress from KS1 for particular groups within cohort e.g. Free School Meal pupils and Higher Attaining Pupils.
- Fresh curriculum provision and operating model introduced in 2011 starting to impact positively on pupil standards.
