Our Pupil Forum vision...

Our classes discuss ideas by...

We meet every fortnight on Wednesdays in the meeting room at 1:15pm-2:00pm. Our meetings are run by Ivy (Chairperson).

Our class gets ideas to the Pupil Forum by...

- Speaking to any of our Pupil Forum members.
- Discussing ideas during specified time in classes.
- Writing an idea/opinion on a piece of paper and putting it in the 'voice box'.

When you give the Pupil Forum an idea they will...

Discuss the idea and if necessary vote on it. Discuss possible action plans and decide **what** the action will be, **who** will be in charge of the action, and when it is reviewed.

We choose people to be on the Pupil Forum by...

There are 17 members of the Pupil Forum, 2 members in each class. There are 3 members in Year 6 and 2 members who are a voice for our Area Resource Base (ARB).

To become a Pupil Forum member, you need to talk to your class for 2 minutes to explain why you want to be on the Pupil Forum, and explain how you will improve the school. Your class will then secretly vote on their favourite candidates. Class teachers will take the top 4 candidates and pass these onto Miss Goodman. Miss Goodman will

then interview these candidates with Miss Taylor to make sure they know what is expected of them, and whether they will be able to represent their class fairly.
