- The vast majority of children in Year 5 think behaviour is good.
- The vast majority of children in Year 5 feel safe and have an adult they could go to if they were worried or hurt.
- The vast majority of children in Year 5 know what to do if they get stuck in their learning and the teachers will help them get better.
- The vast majority of children in Year 5 feel they are taught how to be healthy.
- The vast majority of children in Year 5 feel listened to, trusted and that they are treated fairly.

Next Steps:

- Ask children to make a list of play equipment they would like to see in the school and survey the other classes. This might be something the PTFA could support.
- Discuss what they would change about the school uniform to see if viable.
- We are changing school dinner providers and so will be looking at the price of the provision we offer.
