<b>Next steps:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Adults in Year 3 to continue to ensure that all that the behaviour policy is used effectively</li> <li>• Adults in Year 3 to ensure that children feel trusted to do things on their own</li> <li>• Adults to ensure that children are learning lots from regular set homework and are providing clear feedback on homework.</li> <li>• Adults to ensure that children get help when they are stuck or have different strategies to use when they are stuck.</li> <li>• Class members on "Pupil Forum" to share outcomes with forum and come up with ideas to address highlighted issues i.e. more play resources</li> </ul>
