Can you identify and write compound sentences using the conjunctions and/or/but/so?

Can you write different types of sentences - statement/ questions/ exclamation/ command?

Can you use both familiar and new punctuation correctly including full stops, capital letters, exclamation marks, question marks, including apostrophes for contracted forms?

Can you identify prepositions and include them in your writing?

Can you read and write silly and non-sense poems?

Can you experiment with alliteration to create humorous and surprising combinations?

Can you discuss simple poetry patterns?

Mathematics

Can you identify one more or one less from a given a number?

Can you count to and across 100 forward & backward?

Can you count in steps of 2, and 5 from 0?

Can you read and write numbers to at least 100 in numerals and in words?

Can you recognise the place value of each digit in a two-digit number (tens, ones)?

Can you recall and use addition facts to 20 fluently, and derive and use related facts up to 100?

Can you add numbers using concrete objects, pictorial representations, and mentally, including: a two-digit number and ones?

Can you recall and use multiplication for the 2,5 and 10 multiplication tables (including recognising odd and even numbers)?

Can you find different combinations of coins that equal the same amounts of money? Can you solve simple problems in a practical context involving addition and subtraction of money of the same unit, including giving change?

Can you identify and compare the suitability of a variety of everyday materials, including wood, metal, plastic, glass, brick, rock, paper and cardboard for particular uses?

Can you find out how the shapes of solid objects made from some materials can be changed by squashing, bending, twisting and stretching?

Can you ask simple questions and recognise that they can be answered in different ways?

Can you observe closely, using simple equipment?

Can you perform simple tests?

Can you identify and classify?

Can you use your observations and ideas to suggest answers to questions?
