Changes to provision have been made to support this. • Adults in Year 1 to continue to ensure that all that the behaviour policy is used effectively • Adults in Year 1 to work with pupils to help them to feel that they are independent learners and trusted to do things on their own • Class members on "Pupil Forum" to share outcomes with forum and come up with ideas to address highlighted issues i.e. being independent learners • Premises review of KS1 playground undertaken and action being taken by Central office- Premises team.
