children they also ran their TV Workshop which was an opportunity for pupils to gain an understanding of what they do as a job and how they got into working in television. We all had a fantastic afternoon.


Year 5 Residential

We would rather the children wear trainers than plimsolls as they offer more support.




Opera Project
