<b>Next Steps:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Circle time to discuss the qualities of 'being a good friend' and team games to build friendships and communication skills – in line with our capabilities curriculum.</li> <li>• Circle time to discuss positive learning behaviours and consequences to our actions.</li> <li>• Pupil forum members to feedback outcomes and discuss the possibility for new playground equipment and how Playground Leaders can support lunch time provision.</li> </ul>
