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Overall conclusions:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The vast majority of pupils in Year 2 find the learning fun and know that their teacher and friends will support them if they need help. • All the pupils think they are learning a lot at school. • The vast majority feel safe at school and all of the pupils know they can trust adults to help them resolve any worries. • The vast majority believe the teachers are fair and listen to their ideas. • All the pupils think their class is friendly and they can be trusted to work independently. • The vast majority know the teacher makes an impact on their learning and they are happy to continue their learning at home.
Next Steps:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Adults to ensure the school behaviour policy is put into practice by all pupils and the rewards and sanctions are explained and reviewed regularly. • Adults to work with pupils to help them to feel that they are independent learners and trusted to do things on their own.
