

<u>Key Instant Recall Facts</u> Year I-Spring 2



I know number bonds to 10.

By the end of this half term, children should know the following facts. The aim is for them to recall these facts instantly.

0 + 10 = 10	2 + 8 = 10	4 + 6 = 10
10 + 0 = 10	8 + 2 = 10	6 + 4 = 10
10 - 10 = 0	10 - 8 = 2	10 - 6 = 4
10 - 0 = 10	10 - 2 = 8	10 - 4 = 6
1 + 9 = 10	3 + 7 = 10	5 + 5 = 10
9 + 1 = 10	7 + 3 = 10	10 – 5 = 5
9 + 1 = 10 10 - 9 = 1	7 + 3 = 10 10 - 7 = 3	10 - 5 = 5
		10 – 5 = 5

Key Vocabulary	
What is 3 add 2?	
What is 2 plus 2?	
What is 5 take away 2?	
What is 1 less than 4?	

They should be able to answer these questions in any order, including missing number questions e.g. 6 + () = 10 or 10 - () = 3.

Top Tips

The secret to success is practising little and often. Use time wisely. Can you practise these KIRFs while walking to school or during a car journey? You don't need to practise them all at once: perhaps you could have a fact of the day. If you would like more ideas, please speak to your child's teacher.

Use practical resources – Your child has one potato on their plate and you give them two more. Can they predict how many they will have now?
