



Class 6 camp Kernow – The Final Countdown!

22nd-24th June



I have put together a list of final reminders:

- Please make sure your child arrives at school between 8:40 and 8:55 as usual. The children are to come straight to the school hall. You may help your child bring their luggage into the hall but we will insist that you do not remain in the hall. If you intend to wave your child off, then you must wait outside. We won't be leaving until 9:30- 9:45am.
- We aim to arrive back to school by 3:00pm on Wednesday, however if we are going to be later we will inform the school office.
- The children are allowed to wear non-school uniform for the duration of the trip but need to be prepared for wet weather and the activities to be undertaken. Waterproofs need to be packed in their day bag and wellies or walking boots need to be worn.
- All medication for the trip must be brought to school on departure day only. It/they should be clearly marked with your child's name, placed in a suitable bag or container with clear instructions as to their purpose and use and handed to Mrs Baxter/Mrs Fritz. Do not put medication in your child's travel bag. Asthma inhalers should be placed in your child's small rucksack (day bag) which will stay with them at all times during the day. **Please ensure all medication is in date.**
- Ensure that they have sun cream packed in their day bag (small rucksack) in case we have some sunny weather! Please label with your child's name. This will be with them at all times. Sun cream **will not** be shared between children. Children are expected to be able to apply their own sun cream.
- Travel sickness medication must be taken at home on the morning of departure. If you wish your child to take this for the return journey, it should be treated as 'medication' and handed to Mrs Baxter/Mrs Fritz with the necessary instructions and clearly marked with your child's name.
- **All pupils (unless your child is entitled to a Free School Meal and you have requested one)** need to bring a packed lunch and this should be in their day bag (small backpack) that they will keep with them on the coach. A ready filled drinks bottle is essential which can be refilled.
- NO MONEY WILL BE REQUIRED.
- Optional: A favourite snack or treat, e.g. a pack of biscuits (no sweets, chocolate or nuts). It will be brought out at the designated 'treat' time and shared. We may not get through them all so don't be offended if we hand them back to you after the trip. Please hand in to a member of staff prior to departure.
- Optional: Camera (preferably disposable or a low value digital camera)
- **Items prohibited: Mobile phones, iPads, Laptops or large tablets, pocket knives, expensive cameras and aerosols.**
- **Please clearly label all of your child's belongings. The school accepts no responsibility for lost or damaged items.**
